The Epistle from Burlington was read in and to the Satisfaction of the Meeting. This Meeting Appoints Sarah Figgott and Hannah Scott to Answer the aforesaid Epistle. Having no further business Offering the Meeting adjourns till fourth day 5 o'clock.

This Meeting met according to Adjournment.

The Representatives being called they all appeared.

Those Friends Appointed to Answer the Epistle from Burlington produced one which was read and Approved of and Signed.

No further business Offering this Meeting Adjourns to the next Yearly Meeting to be held at Tridahaven on the Eastern shore.

At our Yearly Meeting of Women Friends held at West River the 20th day of the 5th month 1765.

This Meeting met according to Adjournment and proceeded to business that may there occur.

The Representatives being called they all appeared so no account.

The Epistle from Philadelphia was read in the Meeting to the Satisfaction of Friends. Ann Thomas Ann Thomas Jones and Mary Plummer were Appointed to Answer the aforesaid Epistle.

This Meeting met according to Adjournment and proceeded to business that may there occur.

The Representatives being called they all appeared with accounts from the Quarterly Meetings which was produced in Writing and read. It appears that Meetings for Worship and Discipline are kept up that love and Unity in a good degree subsists amongst Friends and a care remains in the minds of faithful Friends to put the Discipline in Practice. And Gunpowder Report adds that the Lucanus Recommended by the Yearly Meeting was read in their Meeting, and Separately Answered to in Writing and that care remains to be provided for the Poor Widows and Orphans.

Those Friends that was Appointed to Answer the Epistle from Philadelphia produced one which was read Approved of and Signed.

This Meeting Appoints Ann Thomas Jones and Mary Plummer to send Copies of the Epistle to our Quarterly and Monthly Meetings and to make Report to next Yearly Meeting.
