By Accounts from our several Quarterly Meetings which was produced in Meeting and read, it appears that the Meetings for Worship and Discipline have been constantly kept on the times appointed since the last Accounts (Except one Monthly Meeting occasioned by the sorrows of the Weather) and the Business conducted in a good degree of Christian Order and Meekness; and where any thing appears amiss Care is taken to put the Discipline in practice for amendment - Gunpowder Report adds that Quakers were read in their Monthly Meetings and Answered in Meeting. Likewise a case remains concerning the Poor - The Quakers were likewise read in our Quarterly Meeting and Answers here sent -

Those Friends that were appointed by our last Yearly Meeting at Third Haven on the Eastern Shore to send Copies of the Philadelphia Epistle to the Quarterly and Monthly Meetings, have complied with that Appointment - An Epistle from Philadelphia was read in this Meeting to the satisfaction thereof -

This Meeting appoints Sarah Regeter, Elizabeth Troth and Sarah Smith to answer the aforesaid Epistle -

This Meeting appoints Ann Thomas Jun^r and Ann Robertson to send Copies of the Philadelphia Epistle to our Quarterly and Monthly Meetings -

This Meeting Adjourns till tomorrow after Meeting of Worship No Business presents that requires Entry but good Advice and Exhortation given -

The Representatives being called they all appeared but three who sent their Reasons which were satisfactory to this Meeting -

No further Business offering this Meeting Adjourns till nine o'clock tomorrow Morning -

This Meeting met according to Adjournment and proceeded to what Business may thereto occur -

The Representatives being called they all appeared but four who sent their Reasons -

The Minute in regard to appointing such Persons to the Stations of Elders as are not scrupulous in keeping Negroes has been read in this Meeting and a voted conference held thereon; therefore it is the judgment of this Meeting that it be referred to our next yearly Meeting at Third Haven for further Consideration -

Those Friends that were appointed to answer the aforesaid Epistle produced one which was read approved off and signed -

This Meeting appoints Ann Thomas Jun^r and Mary Plummer to transcribe the Epistle and send it to the yearly Meeting of Women Friends at Philadelphia - No further Business offering this Meeting Adjourns till the next yearly Meeting at Third Haven on the Eastern Shore -
