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Care & generally clear of contributing to the support of war.

Deficiencies respecting making Wills, & settling Outward Affairs are expressed in both reports. — Curney is expressed in the Particulars mentioned in the 7th and 8th reports except that one report hints a deficiency respecting Places of Diversion — That concern appears to support our Testimony against Slavery, & to provide for such of the people as remain in our families, except their Education which is acknowledged to be still too much neglected. — And some Care is expressed to Deal with Offenders tho' not without some unnecessary Delay. The Western Quarter adds that Progress has been made within the Limits of Gunpowder Monthly Meeting since last year in the necessary work of Visiting such as Deviate from our Religious Principles, & is yet continued under care of a committee, but that from Indian Spies they have no Account thereof.

We then adjourned to second day and after the meeting for worship, friends met at the time adjourned to, and after some time spent in silence proceeded to the business. The representatives being called appeared as before, together with Cassandra Carse, Mary and Ann George who gave sufficient reasons for their absence on second day.

We received an Epistle from the yearly meeting of women friends in Philadelphia held in the 9th mo. last, which was read here to the satisfaction of Friends. This meeting appoints Cassandra Carse, Rachel Thomas & Rebecca Bartlett to prepare an answer to said Epistle, and produce to a future sitting of this meeting.

We then adjourn to meet tomorrow after meeting for worship. In conjunction with men friends to confer, consider and conclude on a place to hold our next yearly meeting.

When friends again assembled, and the consideration of the Place for holding the yearly meeting next year being resumed, & a solid assistance in conjunction with men friends, it appears to be the general sense of friends that it will be best for the next meeting to be held at Third Haven & therefore the further consideration thereof.

Then adjourned to the 9th hour tomorrow morning. The 10th of the 6th mo. friends met at the time appointed, and after a profitable time of silence proceeded to business, representatives being called appeared as at last sitting. The friends appointed to forward our last years Epistle to Philadelphia and also to send copies of their Epistle to each of our Quarterly Meetings.

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have complied with that Service. The Friends appointed to prepare an answer to the Philadelphia Epistle produced one, which was read approved and signed by the Elders who directed to forward the same.

Pursuant to adjournment friends assembled, representatives present as before except Lydia Wilson who was prevented by indisposition of Body.

We had had the company of Divers friends from within the compass of Philadelphia yearly meeting, who attended the service of this. Whose labours of Love hath been acceptable. Under a humbling sense of Divine regard we concluded and adjourn until the 6th month next of the Lord's Service.
