Satisfaction Tending to strengthen the feeble mind and stir up the Languid
And Indifferent to more Diligence

Under a sense of Divine Favour Extended to us at this time
We Conclude and adjourn to the appointed time at Baltimore Town if the
Lord permit

At a yearly Meeting of Women Friends held at Baltimore
Town the 2nd of the 6th month 1787

The Representatives appointed to attend the service of this Meeting
from the western Quarterly Meeting are Elizabeth Humphrey Rachel Mather
Rachel Price Sarah Bull Rebecca Williams Hester Tyson Elizabeth Brown
And Lydia Williams and from the Eastern Quarterly Meeting Ruth Hall Sarah
Lamb Elizabeth Davenport and Sarah Smyth who being Called appeared Except
Sarah Lamb Elizabeth Davenport and Sarah Smyth

Written reports were produced from our several Quarterly Meetings
which contain in substance as follows Viz.

That Meetings for worship and Discipline have been kept up
And timely attended by most Friends save a few Omissions in the Western
Quarter occasioned by wet weather and high waters, also in some in the attendance
of afternoon and week day Meetings as also some instances of Drunkenness
Other unbecoming behaviour generally guarded against

That love and unity is in a good degree preserved and laboured for the
An Increase thereof would be profitable is intimated by both reports and a Care
Expressed to discourage Tale bearing &c. and to End Differences when they appear

That a Care is expressed to rest on the minds of Friends to encourage
The youth in attending Meetings and to advise to plainness and against haughty
Company and Conversation the a more general Concern and Labour for a better
For these respects would be truly profitable and is necessary to be attended to

That Friends are mostly careful to observe the Particulars mentioned in the
Fourth Query yet that increasing Care in others is necessary

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That no apparent Breach appears in any of the Particulars mentioned
In the Fifth Query

No Deficiency appears in the Particulars mentioned in the sixth
Query Except in making wills and settling outward Affairs timely which
One Report Expresses a Doubt of its being sufficiently attended to

A Care is Expressd in both reports respecting the Particulars mentioned
In the Seventh the one report intimates an Improvement to be necessary respect-
ing Due Moderation on all occasions

Both reports agree that a good degree of Care subsists
Respecting Certificates of Removal

One report mentions a few Instances of keeping
Slaves which are under Care and both reports agree that a Care subsists to
Provide for such as remain in Friends Families, but their School Education
Appears still to be too much neglected as also their spiritual Welfare

A Care is Expressd to date with Offenders in the manner recommended
The one report intimates that a more timely Care in some Cases might be useful
And the report from the Western Quarter adds that the advice of the Yearly Meeting
Hath been attended to in some Measure, the monthly and most of the Preparative
Meetings having being visited and that in one of their Monthly Meetings a Visit
Hath been performed to nearly all the Families of Friends within the Compass
Thereof to a good Degree of Satisfaction and that they believe a Continuation of
Care therein to be necessary

We then adjourned to the fifth hour this afternoon
Near the time appointed Friends assembled and the Representatives
Being Called appeared as before together with Sarah Lamb Sarah Smyth and
Elizabeth Davenport who gave their reasons for their absence at the former
Sittings of this Meeting being Detained by Contrary Winds

We then adjourned to second day next at the 3rd hour Afternoon
The 4th of the 6th month Friends again assembled near the time appointed
And the Representatives being Called were all Present

An Epistle from the Yearly Meeting of Women Friends in
Philadelphia Dated the ninth month Last was read here to the solid Satisfaction
of Friends Ann George and Mary Parish are appointed to prepare an answer
There to and Produce to a future sitting of this Meeting

The Friends appointed Last Year to send Copies of the Philadelphia
Epistle to the several Quarterly Meetings report that they have Complied
With that service We then adjourned to the Eleventh hour tomorrow Morning
