A concern arose in Mens Meeting which being spread before us, respecting an appointment to visit the Monthly & Preparative Meetings constituting this, which being solidly considered is united with, & Susanna Matthews, Caspandria Cowe, Rachel Lamb, Rachel Matthews, Sarah Matthews, Elizabeth Brooke & Mary Brown are appointed to unite with Men friends in that service, & to report of their care to next Yearly Meeting.

Under a sense of Divine favour continued at this season we conclude & adjourn to the time appointed in the 6th Month next at Baltimore if the Lord permit.
