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amongst us, and after a free communication of sentiments on the subject. There appears a general uniting approbation & concurrence to adopt the said proposal.

And we further agree to propose, that if the next Yearly Meeting held in Philadelphia should be so far satisfied as to direct the division to take place early after the close thereof, that our Eastern shore Quarterly Meeting should after that time report of the state of their Meetings to the Yearly Meeting held in Philadelphia for Pennsylvania & New Jersey. Which we submit to the solid consideration of the Yearly Meeting. Signed on behalf & by request of the Committee by
