Sarah Norris with this Account that their Monthly
and Quarterly meetings have been constantly kept
on their appointed times and the business thereof trans-
acted in a good Degree of Christian order and where
things appear amis they are in some good Degree Carefull
to put the Discipline in praetis and their Weekly Meetings
are kept for the most part on the Days appointed but
Sorrowfull that they are poorly attended on Week Days and
that the friends that was appointed to send the Copies
of the Epistle did comply with the appointment

This meeting Appoints Sarah Browning and Margaret
Browning to Enquire into the reason why the Account for this
meeting was not sent and make report to the Yearly meeting
at west River

Sarah Troth and Lydia Troth is appointed to Transcribe
the Epistle that was sent from Philadelphia and send Copies
