There was a Certificate for our friend Rachel Wilson Directed to friends in Old England read and signed in this Meeting

There was an Epistle from the Yearly Meeting in London which contained good and wholesome Advices read in this Meeting to the Satisfaction thereof

The Queries and the Answers were sent from the Quarterly meeting at West River and read in in this meeting

This meeting appoints Lydia Troth and Sarah Smith to Transcribe the Philadelphia Epistle and to send Copies to the Quarterly and Monthly Meetings and make report thereof to next Yearly meeting

The business in regard to appointing such to the Station of Elders that are easy in keeping Slaves has been under the Consideration of this Meeting and it is referred to the next Yearly meeting
