31st of the month and 6th of the week,

the Yearly Meeting of Friends held in
London, produced one, which being read
and deliberately considered was united
with, and the clerk was directed to trans-
cribe it, sign, and forward it accor-
dingly.

The committee appointed at a
former sitting to ascertain whether
this meeting could have the privilege

of occupying friends meeting house in
the Eastern District, reported that
application had been made, but there
appeared an unwillingness to grant the
request. The same friends were continued
with the addition of William W. Handy,
Daniel Cobb and George Williamson to
provide a suitable place for the accom-
modation of this meeting and of friends
of the city of Baltimore, and report at
a future sitting.

Then adjourned to 10 o'clock
