and Nicholas Popplein residing in
the City of Baltimore, were appointed a
committee to whom all minutes or certificates
issued by Monthly or Quarterly Meetings
for any of our Ministers or members are
to be forwarded, and in addition to the
usual signatures of the clerks, they are
to be signed by at least one of the said
committee, and forwarded to the meeting
to which they are addressed.

The committee appointed at a
former sitting, reported that they have
provided a house in St Paul's Street for
the present accommodation of this Meeting,
and the members of our Religious Society

in this City. It was concluded, that here
after Baltimore Monthly and Quarterly
Meeting be held there: and that the mem-
bers residing in the City heretofore composing
the Preparative Meetings for the Eastern
and Western districts, in future consti-
tute one Preparative Meeting; and meet-
ing for worship, also to be held there. The
week day meeting to be held on 6th day,
and the Preparative meeting the week pre-
vious to the time of holding the Monthly
Meeting. The Monthly and Preparative
Meeting to be hereafter known and dis-
tinguished by the names of Baltimore
Monthly and Preparative Meetings
for the Eastern and Western Districts. The
clerks to furnish the Quarterly and Monthly
Meetings with a copy of this minute.
