Meeting adjourned to ten o'clock to morrow morning.

Men friends informed that in compliance with a request from Virginia Yearly Meeting they had appointed a committee to meet such committees as may be appointed by Philadelphia and North Carolina Yearly Meetings to unite with them at their next annual Assembly in considering the propriety of discontinuing that meeting.
