Thus unhappily, the minds of many of the members of Nottingham Quarterly Meeting, became prepared to reject the Authority of the Yearly Meeting, and to act in open violation of the discipline and order of Society.

It will be remembered that Samuel Cope, brother of Morris Cope, and three other members of Philadelphia Yearly Meeting, attended our last Yearly Meeting, and assisted Nottingham Friends in effecting a separation from the body, and in their attempt to organize a Yearly Meeting under our name.
