Some care is taken to guard them against reading pernicious books - and from the corrupt conversation of the world, and to encourage the frequent reading of the Holy Scriptures. Yet a more

deep religious concern with regard to the important requisitions of this query is greatly to be desired.

4th Summary

Most Friends maintain our testimony to a free Gospel Ministry agreeably to our discipline.

5th Summary

Most Friends maintain our testimony against the use of distilled spirituous liquors. Friends avoid frequenting Taverns. Some of our Members attend places of diversion. We believe that temperance and moderation are mostly observed.

6th Summary

The necessities of the poor are inspected and relieved - They are advised and assisted in such employments as they are capable of. No children among us requiring such aid.

7th Summary

We believe that Friends maintain a faithful testimony against oaths, military service, clandestine trade, prize goods, lotteries and slavery - Those of the African race under the care of Friends are suitably provided for - and mostly instructed in useful learning.
