

law might be fulfilled in us, who walk not after the flesh but after the Spirit." "Knowing this, that our old man is crucified with Christ, that henceforth we should not serve sin." We have been exhorted not to rest short of the realization of this blessed experience, so clearly and succoringly set forth in the Gospel, not a privilege limited to the few, but an offer to all, of the free gift of complete salvation through faith in our Lord Jesus Christ. Hear His own words, "whosoever believeth on me out of him, shall flow rivers of living water," and this spake He of the Spirit which "they who shall believe on Him should receive." Do we not believe on Him? Have we known that our sins are forgiven for His name's sake? Then surely it depends on ourselves, whether we will accept and abide under the cleansing operations of the Holy Spirit. Let us yield our wills unto Him, that they may be brought into entire subjection to the will of God, that He may work in us and by us accordingly to His good pleasure. How blessed would be the result in our daily lives. How would our religious meetings come to us seasons of spiritual refreshment, and of fervent exercise of soul for

those around us. And in our families, in all our social relations, we should be enabled to maintain a watchful, tender, waiting spirit, that would be felt both as a rebuke and as an encouragement.

Our work, our reading, our social enjoyments, would all be brought into their right places, and we should be enabled to fulfil the injunction, "Whatsoever ye do in word or deed, do all in the name of the Lord Jesus; giving thanks unto God and the Father by Him".
