

in separate session. The minutes of 7th and 2nd days were read and accepted.

The Queries were read, and the answers from the subordinate meetings, and the following summaries were adopted, - as representing the condition of the meeting at this time.

Summary Answers.

1st All our meetings for worship and discipline have been held and well attended, except one for discipline at Hopewell.

First day Evening Meetings are small in Baltimore, and more punctuality is desirable on the part of some - unbecoming behavior avoided.

2nd Friends appear to maintain love toward each other, becoming our Christian profession. Tale-bearing and detraction are discouraged. No apparent differences amongst us.

3rd We believe most Friends endeavor by example & precept to bring up their children and those under their care in the nurture and admonition of the Lord, and to some extent, in that plainness and simplicity of life, which the Gospel enjoins. They endeavor to

guard them against reading pernicious books and from the corrupt conversation of the world and they are encouraged frequently to read the Holy Scriptures.

4th Friends maintain one testimony to a free Gospel Ministry.

5th We believe Friends maintain our testimony against the use of all intoxicating liquors. One report makes some exception regarding the latter part of this query.

6th The necessities of the poor and the circumstances of those who appear to require aid, are inspected and relief extended.

7th Friends' children generally attend school and when practicable, schools under the care of Friends.

8th We believe Friends are clear as regards this query.

9th Friends appear careful to live within the bounds of their circumstances and to avoid involving themselves in business de-
