

The Queries were read, with the answers to them from the subordinate Meetings, and the state of Society considered. The following is a summary of the answers, viz:

Summary.

Ans 1. - Our meetings for worship and discipline have been held, except seven; four of which were omitted on account of sickness and stormy weather. They have been generally well attended. One report states that their meetings for discipline have not been well attended, and another that the First day night meetings have been small. A want of punctuality is noted in one. Friends generally avoid unbecoming behavior.

Ans 2. - Friends endeavor to maintain love toward each other becoming our Christian Profession - Tale-bearing and detraction not sufficiently discouraged - When differences arise, endeavors are used to end them -
