First - Ministers & Elders when of ability, are mostly diligent in the attendance of meetings for worship & Discipline, & we believe they encourage their families to that religious duty.

Second - Ministers in the exercise of their gifts, appear careful to wait for divine ability.

Third - As far as appears Ministers & Elders are in unity one with another & with the meetings to which they belong & we trust they are concerned for the advancement of truth & the support of our Discipline.

Fourth - We believe that Ministers & Elders are exemplars in uprightness, temperance & moderation & that they are concerned, to labour to educate their families, in plainness of dress & simplicity of manners, becoming our religious profession; but an excess of this concern would be regrettable.

Then adjourned to nine o'clock on fourth day morning next.

Second of the Month & fourth of the month Friends again assembled.

After a time of inward quiet waiting & travail of spirit, wherein we have been more especially favoured to experience our minds baptized into

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a feeling of sympathy one for another & desire for the prosperity of the Church in this place & the spread of the blessed cause of truth & righteousness in the earth, under a canopy of solemnity the meeting adjourned to meet at the usual time next year of the Lord's permit.
