Endorsed by York Quarterly Meeting held at York the 23rd of the 9th month 1846. Also a Certificate from the meeting of Ministers & Elders held in London the 15th of the 10th month 1846 - all expressive of unity with him in his prospect of accompanying Benjamin Subhorn in his proposed religious visit to Friends & others on this Continent. which were read to our satisfaction & the Clerk is directed to present them to the notice of the Yearly Meeting.

Certificates & Minutes were produced by several Brethren & Sisters attending this meeting from within the limits of other Yearly Meetings, as follows - One for Nathan Colby a minister from Ferrisburg Monthly Meeting State of Vermont. One for Thomas Wells a minister from Meana Monthly Meeting Endorsed by Meana Quarterly Meeting, State of Ohio. One for Anna Adams, a minister from Marlborough Monthly Meeting State of New York. A Certificate was also produced for one friend Abigail Redboag a minister from Ferrisburg Monthly Meeting, Endorsed by Ferrisburg Quarterly Meeting, State of Vermont, who we are informed is in this City but prevented from being present by indisposition - Also a minute for Nathaniel Sands an Elder from State of New York - They were severally read in this meeting to satisfaction & the Clerk directed to present them to the notice of the Yearly Meeting.

The queries were read in this meeting & the answers from the Subordinate Meetings, from which the following

summary answers were collected as nearly representing the present state of this meeting viz -

First Ans - Ministers & Elders, generally, are diligent in the attendance of Meetings for worship & Discipline, and we believe they encourage their families to that religious duty.

Second Ans - Ministers in the exercise of their gifts appear careful to wait for divine ability.

Third Ans - As far as appears, Ministers & Elders generally, are in unity one with another & with the meetings to which they belong. Manifesting a religious concern for the advancement of truth & the support of our Discipline.

Fourth Ans - We believe Ministers & Elders are concerned to be exemplary in uprightness temperance & moderation, & that they endeavour to educate their families in plainness of dress & simplicity of manners becoming our religious profession.

Then adjourned to half past eight o'clock on fourth day morning.

20th of the month & fourth of the week - According to adjournment Friends again assembled.

Under an humble sense of our own weakness & unworthiness and of the continued goodness & mercy of the Lord manifested in this occasion amongst us & towards his Church & people, we desire to bless the name of the Lord & to commend each other to his holy keeping - The meeting concluded under a canopy of solemnity to meet at the usual time next year if the Lord permit.
