"Our beloved friend Sarah G. Humphrey wife and Companion of our beloved friend Stanley Humphrey attended our Yearly Meeting in 1879 and produced a Certificate of unity from Dury Monthly Meeting. Sudbury England. Her exemplary deportment and Gospel labors have been acceptable to us."

The Committee appointed at a previous sitting on the Subject of the pastoral care of our Meetings & Members proposed the following which was directed to be forwarded to the Yearly Meeting for its judgment as follows.

This Meeting was brought into deep exercise in considering the Condition of our smaller Meetings and the great need of more systematic labor amongst them. The responsibility of caring for the wants of the flock was felt to rest largely upon this body and with the view of having this important work more efficiently attended to it was concluded to recommend to the Yearly Meeting the Appointment of a Committee - to keep in Correspondence with our Meetings and Members. Endeavor to promote the Holding of a series of Meetings on the Visit of Suitable friends, in all our Meetings and in general to exercise such a systematic care as shall seem best adapted to promote the Spread of the Gospel and the Edification of the Church.

We recommend that the Yearly Meeting appropriate \$300 to defray the necessary expense of the work at the discretion of the Committee and we also nominate to the Yearly Meeting the following friends to constitute such Committee for the ensuing year - viz - Francis J. King. Ed Carey Thomas. Wm. Carey. Deborah C. Thomas.
