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whose love for souls is so intense, will lead us into quietism or inaction.

Some speak of the failure of Quakerism who fail to be true Friends themselves.

The Church is a body with a head, Christ Jesus, and a free ministry is known where all are free to offer themselves, and do offer themselves to Him for service. Such meetings will be a living testimony to the power of the present Lord, and those that minister would speak, baptizing the hearers into oneness with Father, Son & Holy Spirit.

The first requisite of true service is consecration. The history of our Church is the history of the individual faithfulness of our members. The exercise of the various gifts, which we believe all are intended to receive and

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occupy, has enabled Friends in the past to adorn the doctrine of Christ our Savior and to win souls unto Him, and in this, consecrated and gifted women have always taken an important part.

Put yourselves into the Lord's hands. expect the power to be divine power so with the Spirit of the Lord come upon you and you shall say, when called to any service, "I can speak," "I can do all things through Christ which strengtheneth me." The walls of Jerusalem were built in Nehemiah's time because the people had a mind to work.

We have been reunited together in love by the Lord's dealings with us as a Church. In our unity is our strength. Let us continue to work together and may His blessing rest upon the labor of the coming year.
