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experiences. If we have been set free to serve, set free from the power of sin, set free from the observance of rites and ceremonies, we are to remain free, and not be entangled again in any yoke of bondage. Every advanced experience includes within it all the experience that has gone before. But who is there of us that has not at sometime fallen back in some of these respects for a season? The secret of successful experience is to be found in the exhortation. "As ye therefore have received Christ Jesus the Lord, so walk ye in Him". As we received Him as our Saviour without reliance on our own strength, so let us trust and obey Him continually.

The place where the disciples received the great Commission was the place which Jesus had appointed them. In the same way it is, as we are in that condition and that place where the Lord would have us to be, that we receive His teaching and His blessing. He who has said "Go into all the world and preach the gospel

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to every creature," has, in giving us this command, given a still more universal assurance upon which it is based that all power has been given unto Him in Heaven and in earth, and has left us also an equally universal promise. "Lo, I am with you always, even unto the end of the world". We shall experience the fulfillment of this, as we obey the injunction to teach the observance of all things that He hath commanded us being careful to observe them ourselves.

By living with the Lord, we get into His spirit and become partakers of the same yearning for the lost that He has, and this becomes as a fire in the heart. We are apt to think within ourselves, what is our gift? and we often lament that it is so small, but, dear Friends it is not our gifts that the Lord wants so much as ourselves. When God wished to give His best gift to the world, He sent His Son who was made in the likeness of men. In the

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
