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limits of these meetings" as way might open. He still he had been favored to perform the service which he felt the Lord had called for at his hands.

This meeting has requested that he give an account of his visit at a joint session of the Yearly Meeting from which a report may be made to be read at a ^{future} session of this meeting.

He also produced a minute from the Morning Meeting held in London the 27th of 7th Mo 1896. expressing their warm appreciation of his earnest and loving labors amongst them, and their belief that they had been graciously blessed to all, and especially to the younger Friends.

A letter was received from our dear friends Rich^d. H. & Anna R. Thomas and it was directed to be laid before the Yearly Mtg in joint session.

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The Representatives were requested to bring forward to the next session of this meeting the names of two Friends to act as Clerk and Assistant Clerk for the ensuing year.

Then adjourned to 9 o'clock next Fifth day morning.

Fifth-day morning. 11th Mo. 12th Friends met at the hour adjourned to. John C. Thomas on behalf of the Representatives reported that they had conferred together and were united in proposing Jos. P. Elliott for Clerk and Arthur D. Stables for assistant Clerk, which being separately considered, were united with and they were accordingly appointed.

A summary of the exercises in the first session of this meeting was presented and read, and after some corrections it was directed to be forwarded to the Yearly Meeting. It is as follows:
