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Minutes of the "Executive Committee of the Pastoral Committee appointed by the Early Meeting 10th mo. 1881 -

At the first regular meeting of the Executive Committee of the Pastoral Committee held in Baltimore mo 1881. in connection with the monthly meetings Cooperating Committee ^{Chairman} all except two members from each Committee from J. D. King brought before the meeting the necessity of some organization of the young men and of an advanced and deepening of the religious experience of the members of our meeting. Dr. Thomas stated that he was especially concerned on this subject and intended setting together the men of the meeting in a weekly class for studying and distinctive views -
