Elliott were appointed a subcommittee to confer with the members of that meeting with reference thereto and also to see what could be done in this meeting towards raising money to assist in erecting the proposed building.

Mary S. Thomas reported that there had been three religious meetings held in connection with the last Quarterly Meeting.
