

Balto 5th Mo 15th 1882

At a meeting of the Executive Committee of the Y.M. Pastoral Committee with Co-operating of the Monthly Meeting held this day, Chairman absent thirteen members present.

The minutes of the last meeting were read and approved. On behalf of the Washington Lab Committee it was reported that meeting to have been visited by Deborah C. Thomas and Elizabeth R.
