R. Keave was prevented from attending, as he expected -

Elyth R. Hopkins reports that the way had not opened for arranging any meetings at houses of friends

The series of meetings appointed by this Committee to be held here was reported to have been held, commencing 3rd day mo to 3rd day of following week inclusive, thirteen meetings in all - Our friend John Dordani, who was especially invited to be present by the Committee attendees, his services were very helpful & acceptable and the Meetings were large and we think abundantly blessed.
