This action of the Clerk was duly approved by the Board.

~~The following statement of the Trustees of the Thomas King Involuntary Association was read and directed to be entered on our Minutes~~

The Committee on Titles to Meeting House properties had nothing to report at this time.

A Member of the Board informed the Board that on visiting Germersville Meeting in Eighth Month last, he found that the Policy of Insurance on the Meeting House, had been either Cancelled or allowed to expire without being renewed; and feeling the importance of prompt attention to the matter, he assumed the responsibility of having the property insured to the extent of \$1000 for a term of three years at a cost of \$12.00.

The Board authorized this amount so advanced by him, to be repaid to him by the Treasurer of the Yearly Meeting.

The Committee on Titles to Meeting House properties was directed to make necessary inquiries as to existing insurance on Friends Meeting Houses, within the limits of the Yearly Meeting,

and if, in their judgment, any such are not properly insured, they are to endeavor to have the same promptly attended to by the proper parties.
