for the term of five years ending with the close of Yearly
Meeting 1910

The Clerk was directed to so enter these names
on the list of Members of the Board

The Committee on "Lilles to Meeting House Properties"
reported through its chairman, that as directed by
the Board in 18th Month last, letters of inquiry in
regard to Insurance on Meeting Houses had been forwarded
to the several Meetings, but that replies had not
yet been received from all of them. He reported
that he had paid three dollars for Insurance
on "Neill's Chapel" and the Treasurers of the Yearly
Meeting was authorized to pay him this amount.

The attention of the Board was called to reported
outrages committed upon Natives of Congo State Africa,
with request that if way opened, some action be
taken in the way of appeal to our Government, to use
its influence against the continuance of such inhuman
treatment. The Clerk of the Board was directed to
report the matter to the Chairman of the Committee on Legislation
of the Five Year Meeting, as properly pertaining to the duties
of that Committee - with request that they look into
the matter and give it such attention as in their
judgment shall be required. (The done 1906)

At a special Meeting of the Permanent
Board of Baltimore Yearly Meeting of Friends, called in
accordance with Minute No 30 of the last Yearly Meeting

represent Baltimore Yearly Meeting in a General Conference
of American Yearly Meetings on the subject of Foreign Missions
