As the Board will note by the above, there are six properties not insured, viz., Hopewell Meeting House, Corinth School House, and Bethel, Black Creek, Somerton and Fishertown Meeting Houses.

The Committee would ask for instructions as to further procedure on their part in reference to these properties, and whether they are authorized to extend financial aid to the Meetings if they are unable to meet the expense of such insurance.
