By Minute 34 of the Yearly Meeting of 1907 the
Board is informed that the following Friends are appointed
members for the term of five years ending 11th mo. 1912,
viz - Robert L. Conis, Nathaniel T. Russell, John R.
Carr, Rebecca E. Thomas, Thomas Muehling, Louise
T. Hodge, Edward J. Wilson.

By minute 41 of the Yearly meeting of 1907 the Board
is informed that the time of holding a meeting of this
Board is changed from "Baltimore Quarterly Meetings
in First month" to "Baltimore Quarterly Meeting in
Third month."

By minute 42 of the Yearly meeting of 1907, the
matter of urging the influence of the Yearly Meeting in
favor of national legislation forbidding the interstate
traffic in liquor when against a State law, was
referred to this Board for action. Howard M. Hoge,
John N. Barker and Sara H. Hoge were appointed to assist
the clerk in preparing a suitable memorial to be
signed by the clerk and forwarded to the Senate and
House of Representatives of the United States; and to such
individual members of Congress as may seem best.
