

The foregoing minutes of the Permanent Board of Baltimore Yearly Meeting from third mo. 27th 1909 to Eleventh month 12th 1909, both inclusive, were read in today's session of the Yearly Meeting and approved -

At a stated meeting of the Permanent Board of Baltimore Yearly Meeting held third month 26th 1910 18 members were present.

By Minute 28 of last Yearly Meeting the Board is informed of the following appointments as members of the Board to fill vacancies then reported to the Yearly Meeting by the Board, viz: Samuel N. Brown, Jas. G. Whitlock, R. Viola Borisberg, John N. Parker, Samuel R. Neave, Richard A. Rieko, W. Virgil Eastaling, for the term of five years ending Eleventh month, 1914. The clerk was directed to enter these names on the list of members of the Board.

The disposition of the sum of \$1,000⁰⁰ received from the sale of Mill Chapel having been referred to this Board by Minute No 8 of the Yearly Meeting of 1908, we are directed in appropriating the same to the new meeting house now building at Bethel, Va.; and the Treasurer of the Yearly Meeting is directed to pay the same, with accrued interest, to John R. Cary, Treasurer of the Evangelistic and Church Extension Committee.

The desirability of legislation by Congress modifying the form of oath used in United States Courts, removing the imprecatory clause, having been brought to the attention of the Board, we record our judgment that efforts should be made to secure an Amendment to the Revised Statutes which would accomplish this result; and we appoint the following Committee
