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At a called meeting of the Permanent Board of Baltimore (Yearly Meeting of Friends (Orthodox)) nine members were present, and the following action had, viz:

Baltimore, Md., 12th mo. 9th, 1912.

At a meeting of the Permanent Board of the Baltimore Yearly Meeting of Friends (Orthodox) held this day, the following Resolution was adopted:

To the President of the United States.

The Permanent Board of the Baltimore Yearly Meeting of the Religious Society of Friends (Orthodox) regretting the action of the United States Senate in its refusal to confirm, without amendments, the arbitration treaties, as negotiated through the State Department of the United States with the Kingdom of Great Britain and the Republic of France, respectfully urges the President of the United States to re-submit the treaties to the Senate, with a recommendation for ratification in their original form, believing, as this Society does, that such treaties are indispensable steps in the direction of universal peace and the removal of causes for wars.
