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The adjourned Meeting of the Permanent Board assembled at 7 P.M., 14th Mo. 16th, 1923 at Homewood, with eleven members present.

Patterson reported \$4000⁰⁰ Insurance carried on their Meeting house property.

The Committee on Title & Meeting house property reported verbally that the title to Bellefonte property was in process of transfer to Balt. Yearly Meeting but that the legal steps necessary and Court proceedings were very slow.

The Committee was encouraged to complete the transaction and draw on the Treasury for the necessary expenses. Not to exceed \$200⁰⁰.

The Committee reported sale of Elkhorn Valley Meeting property for \$1500⁰⁰. Two hundred of which is now in their hands and the remainder expected at an early day.

The Clerk is instructed to sign any documents deemed necessary in the transfer of the Bellefonte property.
