The stated meeting of the Permanent Board of Baltimore Yearly Meeting of Friends (Orthodox), was held at Sedley, Virginia, Ninth Month 26th 1928. Fourteen members were present.

The minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

It was recommended that the memorial of the life of John R. Cary from Baltimore of quarterly meeting be read in the Yearly meeting and be printed in the minutes.

The Committee on Titles reported that the sale of the Cowensville meeting house property had been completed and that the net sum of ~~of~~ eighteen hundred sixty-four dollars and fifty cents had been turned over to the Trustees. The Committee also reported that the sale of the Bellefonte property was in progress. They were encouraged to press the matter to a conclusion.

Richard Friends reported that they were trying to find a suitable meeting house and

185 requested the Permanent Board to authorize the loan to them of the money received from the sale of the two above meeting properties to aid in that purpose. They reported having a considerable sum on hand. The Board recommended to the Trustees that the loan be made when a suitable house was obtained, and the details were left to the Trustees.

The matter of fire insurance on the Dormitory at Corinth was brought before the Board, and the recommendation is made that Corinth Friends leave the property insured, but should they not be able to bear the expense of the insurance, that the Yearly Meeting Trustees meet the same.

The Clerk was instructed to notify the Yearly Meeting of the expiration at this time of the term of service of J. Hoge Riches, R. Morris Carey, Joseph J. Hare, Sarah H. Hoge, T. James Hunter, Mary O. Reeve and Thos W. Y. Clark, and of the vacancy caused by the death of John R. Cary.

Thos W. Y. Clark was continued as Clerk.
