A special meeting of the Permanent Board
was called to meet at the Meeting House in Baltimore at
5 P.M. upon the requisition of Lewis C. Moon,
Francis A. White, Miles White, Jr., Lindley H. Clark
and Thomas W. Clark, to consider the Court proceeding
in regard to the sale of the Bellefonte Meeting
House property.

Twelve members were present.

The following ^{resolution} preambles were read and
approved. The petition, bond and deed were read
and approved. Thomas W. Clark was appointed attorney
to acknowledge the deed.

The meeting then concluded

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WHEREAS the Permanent Board of Baltimore Yearly Meeting of
Friends (Orthodox) having full authority to act for the said corporation
has made a contract of sale of the Meeting House Property in Bellefonte,
Centre County, Pennsylvania, to James R. Hughes, of the Borough of Belle-
fonte, Centre County, Pennsylvania, for the price or sum of Two thous-
and dollars (\$2,000.00), subject to approval and confirmation of said
sale by the Court of Common Pleas of Centre County, Pennsylvania; and

WHEREAS a petition of this corporation, Baltimore Yearly Meet-
ing of Friends (Orthodox) to the said Court of Common Pleas in a certain
proceeding in said Court to No. 195 May Term, 1927, to be executed on
behalf of this corporation by the Clerk of the Permanent Board, to which
is appended an original of the contract with the said James R. Hughes
signed by him, and to which is appended a proposed decree of court au-
thorizing and directing the execution and delivery of a deed to the said
purchaser, has been prepared and submitted to this Meeting; and

WHEREAS a bond of this corporation in the penal sum of Four
thousand dollars (\$4,000.00), conditioned for the proper application of
the said sum of Two thousand dollars purchase money thus to be received
by this corporation has likewise been prepared and submitted to this
Meeting; and

WHEREAS the proposed deed from Baltimore Yearly Meeting of
Friends (Orthodox), the succeeding trustee, to the said James R. Hughes,
to be executed and delivered after the entry of said decree by the said
Court, has also been prepared and submitted to this Meeting;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the said sale made as
aforesaid is hereby approved and that the Clerk of the Permanent Board
is hereby authorized and empowered to sign and be qualified to the above
named petition on behalf of this corporation, and the proper officers
of this corporation are hereby authorized to execute on behalf of this
corporation its above mentioned bond and the proper officers are here-
by authorized to forward said executed petition and bond for presentation
to said Court and for filing in said proceeding to No. 195 May Term, 1927,
and upon the granting of the said decree the proper officers of this
corporation are hereby authorized to execute and deliver to the purchas-
er the above mentioned deed upon payment to this corporation of the said
purchase price of Two thousand dollars (\$2,000.00) and in executing said
deed Thomas W. Clark is hereby appointed attorney to acknow-
ledge said deed, to the intent that the same may be duly recorded.
