\$110.00 on sheds and \$800.00 on the dwelling.

and of Martha Elizabeth Council of Bethel
Monthly Meeting, both Elders in their
meetings and the former clerk of the
Monthly Meeting for many years, were
read and appreciatively considered. The clerk

to express the appreciation of the memorials
and the services of the Friends.
