Elton Trueblood was instructed to make an investigation into the progress of this work, to bring back to our archives any and all records which are not being used in the prosecution of this work, and to report fully thereon at the next meeting of the Board.

Urquhart, Clerk of Black Creek Monthly Meeting in reply to a communication from the Permanent Board advising that the insurance carried on the buildings of Black Creek Monthly Meeting seemed inadequate, was read and received a sympathetic hearing. The Clerk was ordered to inform this meeting that their letter of explanation was highly satisfactory.

The attached report of the Trustees of the Thomas King Benevolent Association of Darlington was read and approved.

This concluded the business and the meeting adjourned.
