The stated meeting of the Permanent Board of
Baltimore Yearly Meeting of Friends (Orthodox)
was held at Homewood Meeting House, Baltimore, Md.,
on Third month 26th, 1932.

was appointed Clerk for the day.

The minutes of the previous meeting were read
and approved.

By appointment of the Yearly Meeting, minutes read
44, the following Friends are to serve on the Board
until 1936, Charles H. Hall, Howard M. Hoge, E.
Wistar Raiford, D. Elton Hueblood, Lewis H.
Bethersall, Isaac C. White and Matthew H. Woodard,

and to serve until 1934, J. Hollowell Parker
D. Elton Hueblood reported that all our records
that had been sent to the Virginia State Library
at Richmond, had been returned and the
photostats were also here. He, with R. Viola
Housberg were directed to have all the photostats

records bound in ²⁰⁵ permanent form and charge
the expense to the Records Committee. The local
members of the Records Committee were instructed
to investigate what other records might be
of interest for photostats, by the Virginia
State Lib. and report to the next
meeting of the Board.

The acting Clerk was directed to remind
the permanent Clerk to have the insurance
report ready for the next meeting of
the Board.

Thos. W. G. Clark was directed to
attempt to clear the title of the grave
yard plot lying without the wall at
Beltsfont, making a trip there if need
be and charging the expense thereof to
the Yearly Meeting and report to the next
meeting of the Board.

The Board arranged for the opening of
Yearly Meeting on ^{Sunday, day} Monday, November 11, 1932,
and the arrangement of the program was
left to the Executive Committee.
