About 1912, one acre of land belonging to the
Bethel property was cut off and added to the
County School Board, for construction of
\$100.00 and if the two room public school
constructed upon it, was ever discontinued,
the land was to be reclaimed for the Meeting.
This school has been discontinued, the old house
removed by the County School Authorities, and
consequently the land has been reclaimed
again for Bethel, by its Trustees. There
