The Clerk was instructed to notify the Co-operating Committee that the Permanent Board regarded the period between Tenth month thirty-first and Eleventh month fifth as a suitable and desirable time to hold the Yearly Meeting during 1935.

The Clerk was likewise instructed to advise the Clerk of the Yearly Meeting of the expiration of the term of service of the following members of the Permanent Board:- Howard W. Babb, William E. Furnas, J. Edgar Hiatt, A. Viola Horisberg, R. Ernest Meave, J. Hollowell Parker, and Edward F. Raiford.

The Clerk was also instructed to advise the Clerk of the Yearly Meeting that the name of Mary O. Reeve was omitted from the list of members of the Permanent Board through oversight or some other error, and to take appropriate action.

T. Philip Raiford presented a request from Corinth Meeting ^{for permission} to dispose of their school building, which is no longer being used. The Permanent Board gave its approval to this request, the Clerk being instructed to advise

the Corinth Monthly Meeting that some 219 disposition of the property should be made by the proper authorities.

Miles White, Jr., read a letter from the Richmond Monthly Meeting requesting renewal of the loan made to it by the Permanent Board and stating that economic conditions made it impossible to reduce the principal during the past year. The Permanent Board acted favorably on this request.

The Trustees' Report for Bethel Monthly Meeting was approved, and the Report of the Thomas King Benevolent Association was read and approved.

The meeting was then adjourned.
