GENEALOGICAL INFORMATION

Due to the increasing number of calls for genealogical information and resulting time and care necessary to preserve records already in poor condition from age and use it has been necessary to confine the examinations of records to one person, the Custodian of the Vault. Persons desiring information are therefore required to make written application for searches to the Vault Custodian. Accurate response to questions below will expedite the search and keep charges to the lowest point. For making any search a fee on the basis of \$1 per hour is made, regardless of results. The minimum charge is \$1, which is to be paid when search is ordered. Should further search be desired, an expense exceeding \$5 will not be incurred without first reporting to the applicant.

Information to be given in request

1. Names to be searched for with known or approximate dates.
2. Name of Meeting where search is to be made and community of residence.
3. Miscellaneous items which may appreciably further investigation.

Officers and committees of depositing meetings are privileged to examine all the records of their respective meetings upon making proper arrangements with the Custodian. It is understood that none of the above persons has the right to introduce others to examine the records.

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HISTORICAL SEARCH OF RECORDS NOT FOR PEDIGREE PURPOSES

All arrangements for consulting records must be made in advance with the Custodian of the Vault.

For students and others making historical searches for other than pedigree purposes a minimum charge of \$1 is made for opening the vault, plus \$1 a day for each day search is made. If the search requires more than a week, special arrangements may be made by the Custodian.

It is understood that this schedule of charges applies only to historical searches. For pedigree searches separate regulations are made, which will be furnished by the Custodian of the Vault on request.
