On receiving these communications upon
the subject, they were taken into consideration by
the Committee, and being of opinion that it would
be unsafe to proceed further in the business
without first obtaining the approbation of
Government, we appointed a part of our
number to proceed to Washington with this
view, and have the satisfaction to inform that
the same friendly disposition in favour of the
Indians, and the endeavours of Friends to pro-
mote their civilization, continues to be manifested

as heretofore; so that the way appears now to be
open for such measures to be adopted and per-
=sued in relation to the concern as may be
calculated to relieve the wants and distresses
to which they are at present exposed, and, as
suitable opportunities may offer, to contribute to
=wards affording them such assistance, in im-
=proving their situation, as may be consistent
with the views of the Yearly Meeting.

We have examined the treasurer's accounts,
and find in his hands a balance of Five thou-
=sand and fifty one dollars and forty two cents,
exclusive of the principal of the donation from
our brethren in Great Britain, and \$236¹⁸/₁₀₀
which was placed in the hands of the com-
=mittee residing west of the Alleghany Moun-
=tains, intrusted with the care of the Indians
near Mohicon John's Lake, from whom report
has yet come to hand.
