Ten members present

Friends appointed on the subject of Sarah Lane's bequest, reported, that they received no information in relation thereto since our last meeting. They were continued, to give such further attention to the subject as may be required.

The following communication from the Committee on Indian Concerns of Ohio Yearly Meeting, was received, and read, and referred to the sub-committee appointed on the subject of Sarah Lane's bequest. The Clerk was directed, to acknowledge receipt of the same - viz

"Mount Pleasant 2nd month 26. 1833.

"At a meeting of the Committee on Indian concerns of Ohio Yearly Meeting, held the 1st of the 2nd month 1833.

"By a communication received from the Committee of Baltimore Yearly Meeting, it appears that the subject of the \$500 (\$1000) bequeathed by Sarah Lane for the benefit of the Indian under the care of Baltimore and Ohio Yearly Meetings, had claimed their attention. The Clerk is directed to write to that Committee, stating that we are informed that the claim has not been exhibited to the Master Commis-sioners at Philadelphia. And requesting them to give immediate attention thereto, and that by application to Thomas Stewardson, they may obtain some information on the subject."
