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The Clerk was directed to acknowledge to Lewis Walker Clerk of the Committee of Ohio Yearly Meeting in Indian Concerns, the receipt of the communications forwarded by him, also furnish him with a copy of ours to Lewis Cass. Secretary of War.

Adjourned to meet on the sixth month next as named at last meeting.

At a meeting of the Committee in Indian Concerns held Ballot 6th Jan. 13. 1833.

Present ten members.

The friends appointed in relation to Sarah Jones request reported attention thereto, also that they had correspondence with Thos. M. Mason from whom they have rec^d the following reply.

Your letter of 4th last directed to Elias Gamble and our ms

behalf of the Sub-Committee of Baltimore Yearly Meeting in Indian Concerns came to hand the day before yesterday. I have since seen Elias Gamble who has requested me to write and sign on behalf of both of us. Your communication of 3rd m. 14th last year was received and the reports of your Yearly Meeting and

the Committee in Indian Concerns which were sent to us were faithfully lodged into the hands of the Secretary of the Society in the care of Sarah Jones. At the last Session of the General State Circuit Court for the Eastern District of Penn^a the objections the objections made to all the requests for to any of the writings of Jones or Committee appointed by them and before the Court.

The arguments occupied ten days. The dignity of your Committee for the relief and benefit of the Indians was the 5th then spoken to. The Court meets again next month when an opinion is expected regarding the Legation spoken to.

Should the Legation be deemed good, then will come forward the question, Who are the Society of Friends? to which which may lead to further testimony being taken before the master in Chancery.

Our Spring Court last year did not close till 7th month, and it may be many the close of the Session before we get the opinion of the Court.
