their advice in respect to our accepting a
part of the funds of Government, to aid us
in our efforts for the civilization of the Indians"
having had an elaborate consideration, (and
no way having opened for further proceedings
therein: our Clerk is directed to transmit
a copy of this minute to the Committee of
Ohio, with information that the further con-
sideration of "a plan for the proceedings of
the Committee in future, is referred to our
next meeting in 5th month ensuing.

Adjourned to meet at the dwelling of
Joseph King, Jr. on the afternoon of the 12th of
5th month next at 4 o'clock.
