

The situation of the funds received from Friends of Great Britain for the civilization and improvement of the condition of the Indian natives, under the care of Baltimore Yearly meeting and which it is understood remain in the hands of Isaac Tyson and Philip E Thomas as surviving trustees, having claimed the deliberate attention of the Committee, it is judged proper to request the aforesaid trustees to pay over to Joseph King & Treasurer of this committee the interest and dividends which have accrued thereon including the unsuspended balance on hand at the time of the meeting of the Yearly meeting in the year 1827 - also that they be requested to transfer the principal of the donation to Joseph King & Daniel Cobb and Elisha W Brown to be held by them in trust to be applied under the direction of our Yearly meeting to the purposes intended by the donors.

The Clerk is directed to furnish Isaac Tyson and Philip E Thomas with a copy of this minute, also with a copy of the minute from the Yearly meeting of Friends held in London in the year 1831 acknowledged and received by Baltimore Yearly meeting the same year wherein they recognise the body

of persons by whom this committee is appointed to be the Yearly meeting of the Religious Society of Friends held in Baltimore.
