The following communication from the Committee of Indiana was received and read 8th. "To the Committee on Indian concerns of Baltimore (yearly meeting).

Dear friends, We have been appointed by the Committee on Indian concerns of Indiana (yearly meeting) to attend with the Committee of Ohio (yearly meeting) on the subject of the plan of operations agreed on by our Committee and united with by our Yearly Meeting, to endeavor to come to a more full and satisfactory understanding with regard to the several subjects therein contained, and we were also directed to write your Committee inviting you to appoint a like committee to meet at the same time and place.

We have proposed to meet at Mount Pleasant on the 23rd of 1st mo next and have notified friends of that place accordingly.

It would be gratifying to us to meet with some of you, as we apprehend that a feeling together of the several Committees on the very important subject would have a salutary effect. In love we remain your affectionate friends, James Stanton, James H. Hume, Thomas Evans, David Bailey, Henry Harvey.

Which was duly considered and no way opening for a delegation from this Committee to attend at the time proposed. The Clerk is directed to furnish the Committee of Ohio and Indiana with a copy of this minute also to furnish them with a copy of the Minute made at our meeting 8th 12th (and addressed to Isaac Tyson and Philip E. Thomas) and propose for their consideration the propriety of their also requesting their trustees to pay over the funds, the funds named by this Committee.
