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before the Government of the United States
under this arrangement the concern was pro-
secuted to the satisfaction of the Yearly Meetings
until about the beginning of the year 1827.
in the year 1828 a small part of the members
of Ohio Yearly Meeting joined in the separation
from communion & fellowship with the
society of Friends and in the same year
much the larger part of the members of
Baltimore Yearly Meeting also joined in the
separation; among the number of these was
the two surviving trustees holding the funds
being the Donation of Friends in Great Britain
These funds being thus situated the following
minutes were adopted by our committee
at a special meeting held in the 7th month last

"The situation of the funds received from
friends of Great Britain for the Civilization
& improvement of the condition of the ^{Indian} Natives
under the care of Baltimore Yearly Meeting & which
it is understood remain in the hands of Isaac
Tyson & Philip E Thomas as surviving Trustees
having claimed the deliberate attention of the
Committee It is judged proper to request the
aforesaid Trustees to pay over to Joseph King Jr
Treasurer of this Committee the interest &
dividends which have accrued thereon, in-
cluding the unexpended balance on hand at
the time of the meeting of the Yearly Meeting

in 1827. also that they be requested to transfer
for the principal of the Donation to
Joseph King Jr Daniel Cobb & Eliza H Broom
to be held by them in trust & to be applied
under the direction of our Yearly Meeting
to the purpose intended by the Donors.

The clerk is directed to furnish
Isaac Tyson & Philip E Thomas, with a
copy of this Minute also with a copy
of the Minute from the Yearly meeting of
friends held in London in the year 1831
addressed to, & received by Baltimore Yearly
Meeting the same year, wherein they recognize
the body of persons by whom the committee is
appointed to be the Yearly Meeting of the
Religious Society of Friends held in Baltimore

A Copy of the above minute with the one
therein referred to was duly furnished by our
Clerk to Isaac Tyson & Philip Evan Thomas
respectively, to which no reply has been
received & it remains to be seen whether
a sense of propriety the obligations of the
Contract between the Yearly Meetings of
Baltimore & his, & the wishes of the Donors will
produce a conformity with the uprightness &
integrity inseparable from purity of principle
with desires that the blessings of the Lord
may rest on our endeavours for the Civilization Education
& Christian Instruction of the Shawnee Indians. We are
