

At a meeting of the Committee on Indian Concerns
of Indiana Yearly meeting held at White Water.

Wayne Co Indiana the 1st of the 10th mo 1836.

A Minute was received from the Committee
of Ohio Yearly Meeting stating that that Committee
had recd a Minute from the Court of Balto & Md
on the subject of receiving a part of the appropriation
of Government to aid in Indian Civilization
and informing us that they had directed their
Clerk to write to the Court of Balto & Indiana
informing that there is not a friend full in
their Court to accede to or adopt this important
measure and to enclose a Copy of the minute
on the same subject.

The Minute of the Yearly
meeting alluded to was also received which
informs us that they did not open to accept
aid from the funds appropriated by Government
for Indian Civilization.

A minute was received from
the Committee of Baltimore on the same subject
informing us that they concurred with the
Court of Ohio in the conclusion not to
receive aid from the funds of Government
for the aid of Civilization &c. All of which claim-
ing the consideration of this Committee we are
united in judgement that it would be best not to
receive the aid offered by Government.

The account contained in the Minutes of
Ohio of meeting respecting the \$404 to be
sent us (which sum is now in the hands of
our Treasurer) and the receipt of 96¢ from
the Court of Baltimore is satisfactory & answering
to us.

The Clerk is directed to transmit a Copy of
the above to Balto & Ohio Committees.
