A copy of the following communication directed to be transmitted to us by the Committee on Indian Concerns of Indiana Yearly Meeting was read.
"To the Committee"

on Indian Concerns of Baltimore Yearly Meeting ²⁰⁵

Dear friends

The undersigned were appointed by the acting Committee on Indian Concerns of Indiana Yearly Meeting at its meeting on the 13th of 8th month last to transmit to you such account of our proceedings in our labour for the benefit of the Shawanese as might seem to be of interest to you as being united in the Cause with us.

We therefore proceed to state that early in the Spring of the present year we received an account that the Donation of Dr. Wadsworth had been received by our Agent in Cincinnati in receipt of which information we proceeded to purchase house hold & kitchen furniture forming ultimately to and a quantity of provisions in order to enable us to put up & carry on our contemplated school amongst the Shawanese agreeably to the plan agreed on by the several Yearly Meetings we also employed a family or superintendants and also a young woman to assist in the family and by the report of our deputation you will observe that a new friend has been employed to assist in the school. We have a Can^y standing appointed to engage with another young man to supply the place of the present teacher when he sees proper to return home.

The Deputation on their return made the following report and presented a letter from the superintendant an extract of which we transmit to you to wit "We have attended to the appointment given to report that on arriving at the intended station."
